Works Eligible: Portrait paintings, drawings and sculpture not previously exhibited with CSOPA and completed within the past three years are eligible. Paintings must be framed and wired for hanging with size limit 48" maximum horizontally including frame. Gallery wrap presentation will be accepted at the discretion of the curator. No easels. Sculpture limited to 50 lbs. Please provide pedestals. Artwork must be available for the duration of the exhibition (February 4 through March 2). Submission does not guarantee selection by the CSOPA committee for the exhibit & judging. Substitutions and late entries will not be accepted.

Submissions deadlines: Image submissions by email only (prints and slides will not be accepted) must be received on or before January 2, 2008. Please see Email requirements.
