


Steven Assael

CSOPA is honored to welcome renowned artist Steven Assael as judge. Assael's masterful paintings with classical techniques bring new insight to contemporary settings with rich color and light in dramatic and challenging compositions.

His paintings are collected by individuals and museums worldwide, included in the selections of The Metropolitan Museum of Art; Kumada Corporation, Kobe, Japan; Mr. and Mrs. Philip Messinger; Columbus Museum Of Art, Columbus, OH; Mr. and Mrs. Richard D. Segal; Frye Art Museum, Seattle, WA; Mr. Steve Martin; Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art & Design, Kansas City, MO; Mr. and Mrs. Toshio Takashima; and the Walt Disney Corporation, Burbank, CA.

Steven Assael's work has been featured in one-person exhibitions at galleries including the Naples Museum of Art, Naples Florida; Forum Gallery, Los Angeles, CA; Cress Gallery of Art, University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, Chattanooga, TN; Forum Gallery, New York, NY; and Ann Nathan Gallery, Chicago, IL.

A graduate of Pratt Institute, Steven Assael teaches at both the School of Visual Arts, New York and the Pratt Institute in Brooklyn, NY.

CSOPA 2012 LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD HONOREE

Daniel Greene

Mr. Greene is a former instructor of painting at the National Academy of Design and the Art Students League of New York. He is the author of "Pastel" that was in print for 25 years and "The Art of Pastel," which were published in English, French, German, Spanish, Italian and Chinese.

In 1969, Mr. Greene was elected to the National Academy of Design. Highly regarded as a portrait artist, his subjects include leaders of government, banking, education, and industry. A few of the early works include Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, astronaut Walter Schirra, author Ayn Rand, and William Randolph Hearst. Some governmental portraits include Governor Scott of North Carolina, Governor Laxalt of Nevada, Governor Beliles of Virginia, Governor Lehman of New York, as well as two mayors of New York City. Some later portraits include Dave Thomas of Wendy's, Governor Fob James of Alabama, commentator Rush Limbaugh, Congressman Billy Tauzin, composer Alan Menken and Bryant Gumbel of CBS. Some recent portraits include John and Adele Lehman for Harvard, Eric Widing of Christie's and Governor Benjamin Cayetano of Hawaii. A partial list of sitters includes the chairmen of the boards of Honeywell, Coca-Cola Company, Dupont Corporation, American Express, the New York stock exchange and IBM. Mr. Greene has also painted the deans and presidents of: Tufts, Duke, Columbia, North Carolina, West Point, Delaware, New York, Princeton, Rutgers, Yale and Harvard universities.

His non-commissioned paintings include his famous Subway Series and Auction Houses. Mr. Greene's work is often exhibited in Greenwich at the Cavalier Galleries.

He has been an early supporter of The Connecticut Society of Portrait Artists serving as juror and on our faculty over the years. We present our 2012 Lifetime Achievement Award to Dan Greene, grateful that his astounding painting and ongoing contributions to the art world continue to enrich us all.






