Instruction will include discussion on painterly concepts and how these concepts help the artist set up portraits, and how to evaluate the usage of light, structure, space, and context from a painting's start to completion. Practical problems will be designed to help each student see in ways that develop tangible painting skills. Students will become familiarized with the painting process by in-studio practice. This workshop is open to all levels.
